## **Orkney Integration Joint Board Accounts**

## For the period from 1 April 2020 to 31 March 2021

Notice is hereby given under Regulation 5 (1) of the Local Authority Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 1985 that:

- a. Copies of the unaudited accounts of Orkney Integration Joint Board Accounts for the period from 1 April 2020 to 31 March 2021 will be available for public inspection on the Orkney Islands Council website, <u>www.orkney.gov.uk</u>, from 1 July 2021 to 21 July 2021, both dates inclusive.
- b. The public has the right to inspect the unaudited accounts and associated documents and we usually issue a notice as to when that inspection will take place. This is usually in July. Due to the closure of the Council building to members of the public on account of the coronavirus pandemic, the inspection period will be later this year, once the building has been reopened to the public. A separate notice will be issued to advise the inspection period.
- c. Any person interested may object to the accounts or to any part of those accounts, no later than 22 July 2021 by:
  - Sending their objection in writing, together with a statement of the grounds thereof, to the auditor, Audit Scotland, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor, 102 West Port, Edinburgh, EH3 9DN and
  - 2. Sending a copy of that objection and statement to the authority and to any officer of the authority who may be concerned, both at Orkney Islands Council, School Place, Kirkwall, KW15 INY.
- d. The auditor shall, if requested by the person objecting, the authority, or by any officer of the authority who may be concerned, afford to that person or authority or officer, as the case may be, an opportunity of appearing before and being heard by the auditor with respect to that objection; and any such person or officer may so appear and be heard either personally or by a representative.
