GAMBLING ACT 2005

INFORMATION/GUIDANCE EXEMPT LOTTERIES – CUSTOMER LOTTERIES

Customer lotteries are run by the occupiers of business premises, who sell tickets only to customers present on their premises.

The Act requires the following as regards customer lotteries –

- Ø tickets may only be sold or supplied by the promoter or by someone on their behalf;
- on advertisement may be displayed or distributed except on the business premises, or sent to any other premises;
- Ø the lottery may thus only be advertised on the premises on which it is held;
- Ø no ticket may result in the winner receiving a prize worth more than £50;
- **Ø** no rollovers of prizes between lotteries are permitted;
- Ø each ticket must state
 - a) the name and address of the promoter of the lottery;
 - b) the class of persons to whom the promoters can sell or supply tickets;
 - c) that the rights conferred by the sale or supply of a ticket in a customer lottery are not transferrable;
- ocustomer lotteries may not take place within 7 days of another customer lottery promoted on the same business premises.

Customer lotteries may not be conducted on vessels. The Act's definition of a vessel is -

- o anything (other than a seaplane or amphibious vehicle) designed, adapted for navigation or other use in, on or over water;
- o a hovercraft; or
- o anything, or any part of any place, situated on or in water.
