The apprenticeship integrates theory and practice from the outset to provide a range of practical skills for managing construction projects.

Apprentices will be involved in assessing projects' commercial viability, solving design, technical and construction problems, managing work activities and resources to provide innovative and efficient solutions to constructing complex projects.

Graduates of the apprenticeship may embark on a range of career pathways including working on landmark development projects such as housing, offices, hotels and commercial development schemes.
