## **NOTES**

- 1. Section 68 provides that :-
  - (1) The appropriate Licensing Board may—
  - (a) on the application of the holder of the premises licence in respect of any licensed premises, and
  - (b) if the Board consider it appropriate to do so in connection with—
  - (i) a special event or occasion to be catered for on the premises, or
  - (ii) a special event of local or national significance,
  - extend the licensed hours in respect of the premises by such period as is specified in the application or such other period as the Board consider appropriate.
- 2. The applicant must be the licence holder.
- 3. Please describe in detail the event for which the extension is required and <u>all</u> activities that will take place as part of the event. Note in paragraph 1 above that the event must be a special one to be catered for on the premises or one of local or national significance.
- 4. Insert the inclusive dates during which the extension is required. Note that as s.68(2) provides that "An extension of licensed hours under subsection (1) has effect for such period as is specified in the application or such other period as the Board consider appropriate; but in either case the period must not exceed one month."
