

Development and Infrastructure Committee: 9 September 2025. ISLANDS COUNCIL Economic Development Grants and Cost of Living Crisis Business Support Schemes – Budget Outturn Statement and Delegated Approvals.

Report by Director of Enterprise and Resources.

#### 1. Overview

- 1.1. In March 2024, the Council approved the revenue budget for financial year 2024/25. This included an initial Economic Development Grants budget of £300,400 along with the capability to over-commit by 5%, which increased the budget to £315,400.
- 1.2. During financial year 2024/25, new spending commitments of £315,400 were approved which, relative to the Economic Development Grants budget of £315,400 as detailed in Annex A to this report.
- 1.3. The level of outstanding spending commitments held in the Economic Development Grants Fund, as at 31 March 2025, decreased by £72,554 to £766,829.
- 1.4. Grant approvals made in the period 1 April 2024 to 31 March 2025 totalled £315,400, including grants approved under delegated schemes for the same period, totalling £202,528 and are detailed in Annex B to this report.
- 1.5. On 21 February 2023, the Policy and Resources Committee recommended that the following Cost of Living Crisis Business Support Schemes should operate for a period of two years to 28 February 2025, funded from the unassigned remaining balance of the Coronavirus Response Fund, estimated at £1.3 million, and reported to the Development and Infrastructure Committee in addition to standard reporting of Economic Development Grants budget monitoring:
  - Council Business Hardship Support Grant (BHSG).
  - Council loan facility.
  - Energy resilience and transition support.
  - Exceptional requests and approvals made up to 28 February 2025, totalling £120,000, in respect of Cost of Living Crisis Business Support Schemes, are summarised in Annex C to this report.

- 1.7. The approved operating period for the Cost of Living Crisis Business Support Schemes finished on 28 February 2025 and there were no subsequent requests to access funding support from businesses in crisis.

  - iii. Note approvals made in the period up to 28 February 2025, totalling £120,000, in respect of Cost of Living Crisis Business Support Schemes, as summarised in Annex C to this report.
